The ensembles will cater for string, wind, brass, and percussion players, from beginner right the way up to grade 8 and beyond. The new ensembles will begin on Monday 25th September 2023 and be hosted at Springwood High School. It will also be completely FREE for the Autumn Term.





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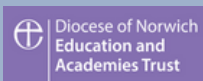
