This Autumn term, we are excited to announce some new after school club opportunities for the children. Each club will be run by Mrs Honhold or Mrs Cole. Please see the options if your child would like to attend one/all of them:

### **Art and Activity Club: Tuesdays (commences 4<sup>th</sup> October)**

This creative 'Activity Club' will be run by the lovely Mrs Cole every Tuesday afternoon. The club will start at 3.15pm and finish at 3.55pm. There will be something new to complete every week or a project to complete over a few weeks and will range from craft and painting, to building and games. The children will be able to take home their creations at the end of the term.
