This half term our curriculum theme is how is the UK different to other countries?



ENGLISH - WRITING

In writing lessons the children will be finishing writing their stories based on the fabulous picture book 'The Quest'. Then they will be writing their own non-fiction texts with information. .



ENGLISH - READING

During this half term, the children will be continuing to focus on applying their phonic understanding in Read Write Inc. In class, we will be using our comprehension skills to practise retrieving answers from a variety of genres and increasing our reading speed.



MATHEMATICS

This term, the children will be focussing on applying their knowledge of the four operations in order to solve problems. The year 2s will continue to develop their understanding of greater numbers and the 3s and 4s will be looking at dividing by 10.



GEOGRAPHY

In geography we will be reminding ourselves of the four countries of the United Kingdom and their physical and human features. We will then compare the UK to other areas of the world, looking at these aspects such as mountains and population.

SCIENCE

We will be continuing to learn about plants. We will look at the conditions needed for growth and try planting our own seeds. We will also carry out investigations to look at how water is transported.

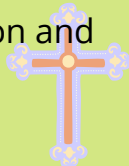
ART

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be looking at the different aspects of Christianity and how these vary across different denominations. We look at baptism, communion and church spaces.



COMPUTING

The children will be learning about how to use microbits in ICT.



FRENCH

The children will be learning how to say the Spanish names of pets, colours and months of the year. They will also revisit language taught last year.

PSHE

The children will be thinking about feelings, rights & responsibilities, being kind and working together.

The children will be continuing to appraise different genres of music and they will develop their skills in performance and composition.
