Message from the Executive Headteacher....



Well done to the staff and children for a super Anti-bullying week last week, which really helped children to think about their Power to Speak up and not to just watch if someone is doing the wrong thing. We reminded the children about the difference between Mean Moments and Bullying - See our poster. Have a look at the photos below of all the super learning across Nar Valley Federation during Anti-Bullying week!

We have also carried out our Pupil Voice survey, asking our children about how coming back to school in the Autumn term was, what is going well at school and what would be even better. We'll also be asking you the same questions and warmly invite you to our Parents/Carers' Forum. These are being held after our Parents/Carers' cafes later in the term - do come along if you can. We also offer an online option for working families later that evening at 6pm, so if you'd like that option, please email the office for the meeting link.
