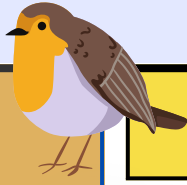
Military Families.....

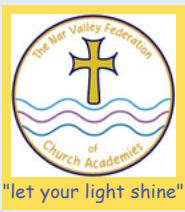

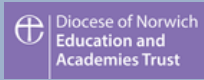

Message from the Executive Headteacher....

The NCA has issued a direct warning to education professionals about the growing threat from Com networks, online communities of predominantly teenage boys that begin around ordinary interests such as gaming or music before migrating to private channels on Discord, Telegram, or Instagram. What starts as a community becomes a hierarchy in which status is gained through the commission or facilitation of harm. Reports of this threat increased six-fold in the UK between 2022 and 2024. The NCA has identified cases in which girls as young as 11 have been coerced into seriously harming or sexually abusing themselves, siblings, or pets. In some instances, victims have been groomed into offending themselves.

NCA Director General Graeme Biggar has been clear on one point that matters especially for schools: these groups are not lurking on the dark web. They exist on the same platforms young people use every day. A young person can be simultaneously a perpetrator and a victim, and the warning signs are not always obvious.
