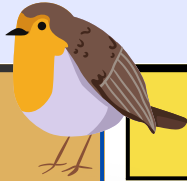
## Military Families.....

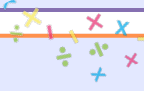

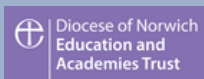
