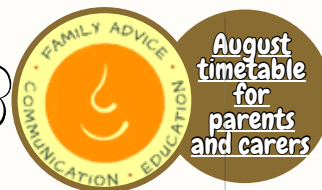

Lunchtime Award

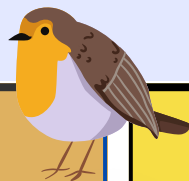
Military Families.....

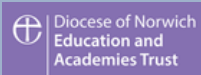
Our week in Class
