	<p>Birds</p> <p>I wonder how you got on yesterday? Did you hear or see any birds? Have you started to fill in your bar chart?</p> <p>Today I would like you to look at the picture below and talk about what you see to a grown up. Please let your child talk first - they may decide to make a story up about what is happening. If they need some help with prompts, some questions you could ask are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is happening in the picture? • Why are the birds carrying the tree? • Where did the tree come from? • Where are the birds taking the tree? How long will it take? • Will they stop on the way? • What will happen when they get there? • Why might a tree need moving? • What are the birds using to hold the tree? • Why did the artist use these colours?


