


Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2020

Hi Year 1 children,

We are half way through the week! I hope you are enjoying learning about Spectacled Bears in Peru.

On this plan you will find today's virtual Maths, Phonics and Handwriting. In Maths yesterday you learnt about partitioning numbers, today is all about comparing numbers. In Phonics you are learning the digraph 'ue' as in "blue" and for handwriting we are learning how to write some more tricky words which will help you with your spelling.
