


Tuesday 30th June 2020

It's Tuesday and the last day of June. Do you know which month is next? Only a few weeks and it will be the Summer holidays!

On this plan you will find today's virtual Maths, Phonics and Handwriting. In Maths you are learning about counting and grouping, in Phonics you are recapping and learning the "sh" digraph and for handwriting we are learning how to write some more tricky words. Don't forget you can write them using chalk, shaving foam, rice- it is up to you!

Task 2-

In the story there are some lovely illustrations. Let's see if we can count and group some of the images.

How many onions? Can you see them in groups of 2?
How many flowers? Can you see them in groups of 2? How many carrots? How many strawberry bushes? Did you need to count them? How else do you see the things growing in the picture?



Look closely at the picture. Can you make some questions to ask a partner like we just did? How many plant pots? Do you see 10? How would you group them? How many seats have got people on them?


