

$$2 \times 4 = 8 \text{ and } 4 \times 2 = 8$$

There are 8 socks in total.

$$2 \times 6 = 12 \text{ and } 6 \times 2 = 12$$

There are 12 footballs in total.

$$2 \times 11 = 22 \text{ and } 11 \times 2 = 22$$

There are 22 fish in total.



Harpritt has added one to the previous number instead of two. The missing numbers should be 4, 12 and 18.

Harriet is right. The multiples of 2 are all even numbers.



There are three possible combinations:

$$2 \times 6 = 12$$

$$2 \times 8 = 16$$

$$2 \times 10 = 20$$
