
Try writing:

Parent answer:

Partitioning the 7 into 6 and 1 is useful as Rosie can subtract the 6 to make 10 then subtract the 1

If you partition 16 into 7 and 9, you can subtract 7

Parent answer:

Teddy has used the = sign incorrectly. 10 – 1 is not equal

10 – 1 is not equal to 15 – 5

He should have written:

15 - 5 = 10

10 - 1 = 9

15 - 5 = 10 - 1 = 9


