Definitions:

- Roots the roots of a plant act as an anchor, fixing the plant into the ground. They also absorb water and minerals to help the plant to grow.
- Stem the stem of a plant grows above the ground. The leaves and flowers grow from it. The stem is also used to transport water and minerals around the plant.
- Leaves a plant's leaves absorb sunlight and turn it into energy that the plant uses to grow.
- Flower the flower is the part of the plant where seeds are made.
