
Hello everyone,

You can compare weight and height by adding  
the suffix 'er' to these words. Have a go at  
adding the suffix 'er' to these words:

light  
tall  
small  
short

You have to be careful when you add the suffix 'er' to the root words big and heavy. Can you spot where the root word has changed?

heavy	heavier
big	bigger

The 'y' in heavy disappears and an 'i' is added to make the word 'heavier'. The 'g' is doubled in the word big to make the word 'bigger'.

**Task 2:**

Choose two objects in your home and write a comparative sentence using a word with the suffix 'er'.

For example, 'The pencil is longer than the teaspoon.'
